

Epsilon Zeta Alumni Association Meeting

President Dave Foye called the meeting to order at 11:35 AM.

A motion to create a 40th Anniversary budget of \$400.00 was approved.

The Association discussed the 1986 Big Red Freakout, for which it had forwarded the cost of 25 tickets. The consensus was that the Association should continue the practice. A motion to have the EZAA forward the cost of 25 hockey tickets for the 1987 Big Red Freakout was approved.

The Association discussed EZ Alumni Chapter Debts, which, collectively, are greater than the combined Chapter Debts of the Active Brothers. The Association decided to contact its own members in order to encourage the paying of Chapter Debts.

The Epsilon Zeta Chapter alumni newsletter has not been published for a long time. An issue was supposed to have been published early in the spring semester; it would have contained information about the COE weekend.

RPI is considering computerized access to information of interest to alumni, such as upcoming alumni events. Steve Flood has agreed to find out more about this topic.

The Association discussed Regional Alumni Branches. Several Branches are forming and planning activities; some method of communication between Branches is necessary. The consensus was that each Branch send copies of its bulletins to the Presidents (or Acting Presidents) of the other Branches.

At the time of the meeting, 34 Alumni had attended all or part of the COE weekend.

The Association discussed the two Bylaws amendments published in the last issue of "The Glump". The amendment transferring the responsibility of producing the EZAA Directory from the Secretary-Treasurer to the Extension Chairman was approved. The amendment deleting the section about Associate Membership failed.

The Association conferred Associate Membership on Suellen Murawski and Marcia Flood.

The Association approved a Bylaws amendment giving the Member-at-Large the job of Association Historian.

The Association decided to hold its Fall Reunion during the weekend of the Installation Banquet.

President Dave Foye adjourned the meeting at 12:10 PM.
